

The Highlands at Mayfield Ranch is Appointing a New Director!

Your Municipal Utility District (MUD) has a unique opportunity to appoint a resident to fill a vacancy for the remaining term of a non-resident Director that recently resigned from the MUD Board. This appointment to the Board will fill the remaining term expiring November 2024. The Director position will then be up for election in November 2024.

The responsibilities of a MUD Director include managing the affairs of the MUD for the benefit of the community which consists of providing the following services:

1. Water and Sewer
2. Garbage Pick-up
3. Streetlights
4. Community Security
5. Greenbelt Maintenance
6. Other services and activities as needed

The MUD is also responsible for establishing and managing a significant portion of your property tax rate. The MUD meets once a month for its business meeting.

To qualify to be a MUD Director, you must:

1. Be 18 year of age or older,
2. Live in the state of Texas, and
3. Be a qualified voter or own taxable property in the MUD district

Therefore, if you are a qualified voter or property owner in this community, you meet the qualifications.
